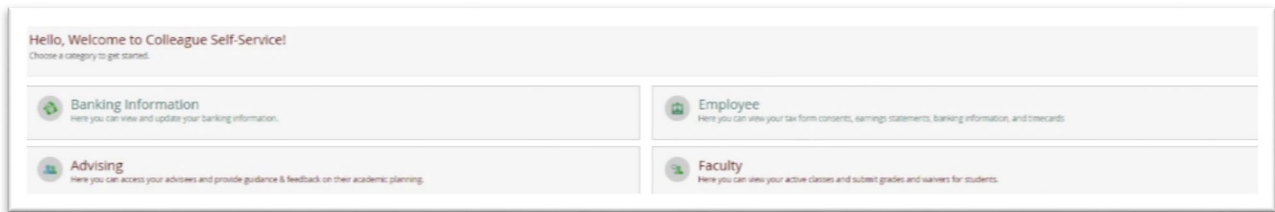
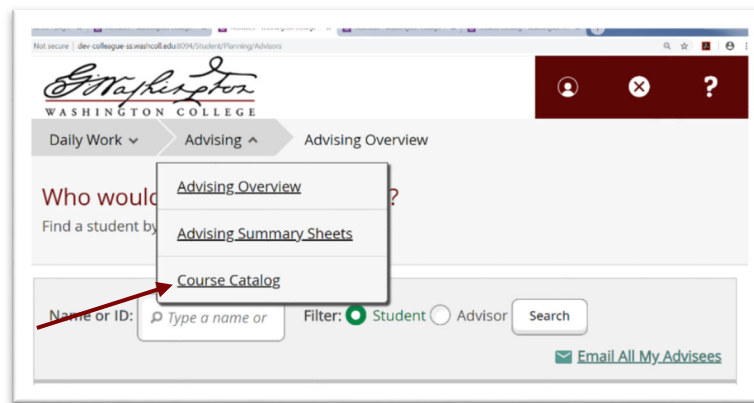


Searching for Courses in Self Service

Login to Self Service. You can access the Course Catalog from any of the following menus: Student Planning, Advising, Faculty, or Employee.

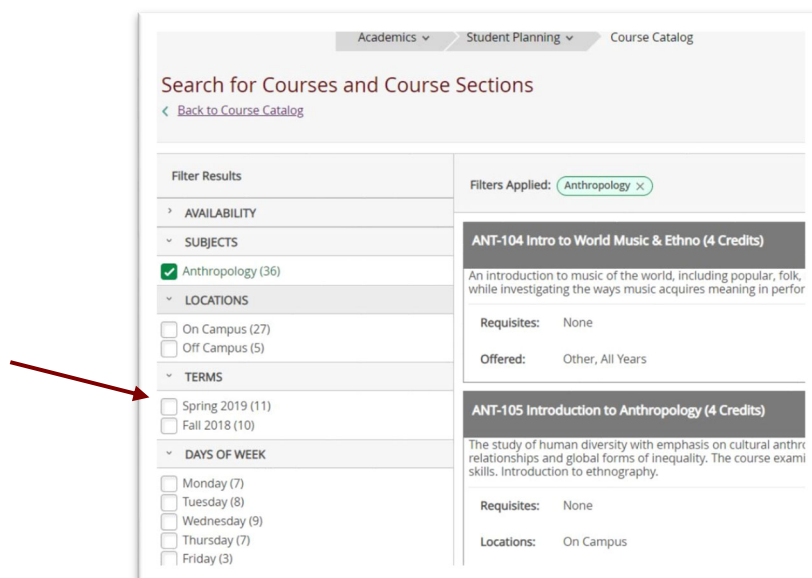


From the Student Planning, Advising, Faculty, or Employee drop down menu at the top, select Course Catalog.



Searching for Courses in Self Service

QUICK TIP! You can search for courses that might meet certain major requirements, or minor requirements. For example, if you would like to find courses that might count toward the Gender Studies requirement, select Gender Studies from the Course Type filter. The Course Type filter is available on the Advanced Search page, and on the results page of any search.

“SEARCH FOR COURSES...” FIELD

At any time, you can also search for a course in the Search for Courses box. Type in any course or subject you would like to view. You can type in as much or as little as you’d like – **just remember to select the term you’d like to view on the results page!**

For example, typing in “ENG” will produce all English courses. Typing in “Anthropology” will produce all Anthropology courses. If you enter in a subject and course number, the course you searched for will appear in the results at the top – followed by all other courses in that subject.
