

## THE 1782 SOCIETY of WASHINGTON COLLEGE ELECTRIC VEHICLE (EV) CHARGING FACILITIES USE FORM

As a current donor to Washington College at The 1782 Society level, I wish to take advantage of the opportunity to use the College's electric vehicle (EV) charging facilities. I understand that I must purchase a \$25 permit, which is not tax deductible, from the Public Safety Office. I understand that upon payment of this fee, the EV charging
stations are available for my use; that EV charging is limited to 4 hours per session; and that each EV must have its
own permit. I understand that my permit is only valid for 12 months, and that I am required to renew my permit
after that. I also understand that the College's first priority is to serve its students, faculty, and staff, and that the availability of charging stations will vary. Additionally, availability may be limited if the College is not in session.

Upon purchase of a permit from the Public Safety Office, you may use the EV stations at any time, subject to availability. You must display the permit in the car while it is charging. Please remember that charging sessions are limited to 4 hours per session, and please move your vehicle to another parking space once it has completed charging. Permits are valid for 12 months from the date of purchase.

Washington College does not assume any responsibility for parking on campus nor for the charging of the vehicles or the suitability of the charging stations. WC will not be held responsible for any damage to the vehicle.
