

American Psychological Association Summer Science Fellowship

- Located at George Mason University in Fairfax, VA
- Dates of the program would be June 8 – July 20, 2013
- Deadline of application is February 11, 2013

- Open to rising seniors only. An expenses-paid, intensive summer training program which gives students an opportunity to explore the intellectual, personal, and social processes of scientific inquiry and to experience cutting-edge psychological research through hands-on laboratory activities. Areas of research can include applied developmental, biopsychology, clinical, neuroscience, and school psychologies.

The Association for Psychological Science

- A minimum 10-week commitment, working at least 3 full days is required, although the availability to work full-time is preferred.
