
## AlcoholEdu for College Student Directions: First-year Students

Washington College has partnered with EverFi, whose mission is to help students address critical life skills such as alcohol abuse prevention and financial literacy in high schools and higher education institutions across the country. Each year over 1/2 million students complete AlcoholEdu for College - their online, non-opinionated, science-based alcohol abuse prevention course.

As part of our comprehensive alcohol prevention program, Washington College will expect each member of the first-year class to complete AlcoholEdu. Whether you drink or not, this course will empower you to make well-informed decisions about alcohol and help you better cope with the drinking behavior of your peers.

## To fulfill Washington College's requirement you must achieve the following:

- Complete the Final Exam with a 85% or higher
- Complete Part 1 (approx. 2-3 hours) by: Wednesday, August 21, 2013
- Complete Part 2 (approx. 15 min) by: Thursday October 24, 2013



Failure to complete this requirement will result in a letter being placed in your student file and may result in judicial action.
