### Overview of data:


- 214 IS graduates from 2002-2017, 64% of whom we're in contact with so far!
- Information on 137 graduates was returned by questionnaire and is reflected in the following data

### Contact:

- Connected with 134 graduates through LinkedIn and 42 graduates via the new IS Alumni Facebook group.
- 49 graduates are willing to engage and be in contact with current students
- 41 graduates have interest in coming "Back to WAC" for career day

### Post-Graduate Education:

- 48 graduates have attended graduate school
- 4 graduates plan on attending graduate school within the next year
- MBA's and International Development were the most common advanced degrees
