Echo Hill Outdoor School's campus offers a comfortable and natural environment for your program. Here are a few guidelines to help in your planning:

- Housing is provided in two rustic dorm lodges. Each dorm sleeps 40 people. In each dorm, four rooms have 3 sets of bunk beds and two rooms have 4 sets of bunk beds; there are shared bathrooms.
- Each dorm has a common room with a sunken fireplace.
- Guests must bring bedding (i.e. sleeping bags & pillows), towels & toiletries.
- All classes are conducted out of doors and proper clothing is essential to the enjoyment all programs. Loose comfortable clothing will allow you to move freely. Long pants or long shorts are great. Sneakers or athletic shoes are appropriate. Leather soled shoes or boots are slippery and will make activities difficult for you. Bring a rain poncho or jacket just to be prepared for inclement weather. We will spend most of our day in the out of doors so include whatever will keep you comfortable!
- Meals are provided in our air-conditioned dining hall "Harris Hall. All meals are served family style with Echo Hill staff seated at each table. Both hot and cold entrees are always available, as well as our salad & fruit bar. Vegetarian options are also available.
- Smoking is not permitted in or around any building.
- For those of legal age, smoking is permitted in designated outdoor areas.
- Alcohol is not permitted.
