



TEST OPTIONAL FORM

The admissions process at Washington College places primary emphasis on secondary school performance. In addition to the secondary school transcript, other items that help to evaluate the potential 'fit' between an applicant and the College include letters of recommendation, the personal statement/essay, and activities profile.

Although SAT and/or ACT scores can, in some cases, help to inform the review process, we believe that students with a strong record of academic performance should not be penalized by test results that are inconsistent with their grades. With this point in mind, we have instituted a 'Test Optional' policy for applicants.

For International Applicants: Please note that all non-resident students are required to submit standardized exam scores (TOEFL/IELTS/SAT/ACT) and are not eligible for the "Test Optional" policy. Please contact the Admission Office for further details.

For homeschooled applicants: Please note that all homeschooled students are required to submit standardized exam scores (SAT/ACT) and are not eligible for the "Test Optional" policy. Please contact the Admission Office for further details.
