OPEN CALL FOR ART

Kohl Gallery is pleased to announce a call for artworks for the
100 Proof Annual Student Art Exhibition

Submissions due by Monday, Feb. 25, 2019

Kohl Gallery's annual 100 Proof Juried Student Art Exhibition is open for submissions from all Washington College students. Selected works will be exhibited from March 28 - April 7, with a public opening reception on March 28 from 4:30-6:00PM.

This year's exhibit is open to all mediums and themes, and all Washington College students from all majors are encouraged to apply. Experimental and ephemeral forms, including proposals for installation and performance art, are also encouraged. Artistic collaborations are welcome.

The 2019 100 Proof Exhibition will be juried by professional artist Mehveş Lelic (www.mehveslelic.com). Lelic is an Istanbul-born photographer now based in Salisbury, MD. Lelic's works have been exhibited internationally throughout the US, France, Turkey and the Netherlands, and she has been awarded the National Geographic Expeditions Council Fellowship, Turkish Cultural Foundation Cultural Exchange Fellowship in the Arts and a City of Chicago Individual Artists' Program Grant.

Final selections will be based on the following criteria: artwork quality (the most important criteria); clarity of submitted images; and logistical feasibility.

Application Instructions:

1. You **may submit up to four artworks** for consideration.
2. Artworks must be submitted as digital images. Ensure that the following image criteria are met:
 - a. images clearly depict artwork against a neutral background with minimal distractions
 - b. you may submit one additional detail image per artwork if needed
 - c. all images should be sized to approximately 6"x8" at 72dpi, max 1MB per image
 - d. all images should be saved as .jpg
 - e. name images with your name and the number that corresponds to the artwork submission form (*i.e., JaneArtist_1.jpg, JaneArtist_1detail.jpg, JaneArtist_2.jpg, etc.*)

4. Submit all images and completed Submission Form in a single email to jwills2@washcoll.edu.

Please use '100 PROOF SUBMISSION - YourFirstName LastName' as the email subject line (*i.e., 100 PROOF SUBMISSION - Jane Artist*)

TIMELINE

- February 25:** Applications due by 11:59PM (Monday) - no exceptions
- March 7:** Selections announced via email
- March 25:** Artwork drop off/ Installation at Kohl Gallery (acceptance email will indicate whether your work must be dropped off or installed by you)
- March 28:** Exhibition opens with Opening Reception 4:30-6pm. Brief artist talks (optional, informal) begin at 5pm.
- April 7:** Exhibition closes
- April 8:** De-installation/ pick up artwork between 2-6pm (all unclaimed artwork will be discarded after the 6pm deadline; no exceptions)
