## Dr. George Spilich

***"Beauty, Lies and Prejudice: Living in a Space  
Age World with a Stone Age Brain"***

Professor Spilich will address how neuroscience explains much of how our brains work, while the new discipline of social neuroscience asks how our brains manage social interactions: How do we decide who is attractive and who is not? Do we know when we are being lied to? Can we accurately interpret the facial expressions of people from other cultures? Join us to find out more about this fascinating research on the human brain.

George Spilich is a recently-retired cognitive neuroscientist who spent 38 years on the faculty of Washington College as the first John Toll Professor. His research has focused on neurological disorders such as concussion and Alzheimer's disease and has been cited in scientific and medical literature over 2,500 times. In 1988-89 he was the successor to two-time Nobel prize winner Linus Pauling at the University of Zagreb Hospital's neurological and nuclear medicine departments. The highlight of his career, however, was meeting the talented students at Washington College.
